May 2025 Meeting Minutes

Meeting started at 6:38 PM

Minutes from March 31st meeting read and approved.

Financial report given by Arlene Winn who reported the current combined WCDC funds including the City line item and the WCDC Projects line as \$1531.46.

Arlene informed the group that the City donation to the Main Street flower project stipulated in an earlier Council meeting was \$1000. Arlene also reported the expenses for the flower project as follows: \$1275 for baskets, \$830 for flowers, greenhouse storage/supplies, and Heritage Wall plantings.

Reimbursement was made to Mike Killgore of \$28.24 for supplies to install plaques on Heritage Wall. Invoices were paid to Leave Your Mark for plaque orders in the amounts of \$115, \$435, and \$141.

Main Street baskets: baskets were hung the first week of May.

Welcome Sites: Arlene, Dave, and Cassandra harvested eight small lavender plants from the grounds at Winn Homestead that Dave transplanted around the covered wagon site. Arlene agreed to research prices for patriotic bunting for hanging on the wagons at both sites.

Heritage Wall: Arlene agreed to spray the wasp nest that was discovered in the plaque application box. The idea for keeping a storage box at the site was tabled. Arlene agreed to assist with ensuring that new plaques are installed in appropriate locations on the wall.

Social Media: Photos of Dave, Arlene, and Cassandra harvesting and planting the lavender starts were provided to Mike who uploaded them, and acknowledged appreciation for their work to the COC fb page.

A photo of Scott Carlson of the Weston Public Works Dept. installing new street signs (a WCDC recommendation) was also uploaded by Mike with acknowledgement of the collaborative relationship WCDC has with the City.

Mural project: Cassandra noted that she has a friend named Johnny Johnson who paints murals. Members were encouraged to brainstorm western themed ideas for the mural.
